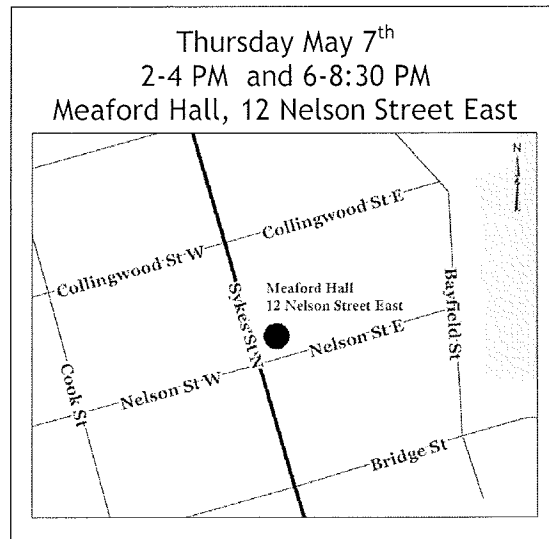


Notice of Public Open House Draft Zoning By-law for the Municipality of Meaford

Thursday May 7th, 2009
2 to 4 PM and 6 to 8:30 PM
Meaford Hall, 12 Nelson Street East

Please take notice that a **REVISED DRAFT** version of a new comprehensive Zoning By-law for the Municipality of Meaford has been prepared. A Public Open House has been scheduled to give members of the public an opportunity to further review and provide comment on the By-law.



The purpose of the new Zoning By-law is to implement the Official Plan and to ensure that zoning regulations are consistent across the entire Municipality. The new Zoning By-law will contain updated provisions that will set out exactly what is permitted on each property in the Municipality and what standards should apply. The effect of this new By-law, once adopted by Council, is to replace the comprehensive Zoning By-laws currently applying to the former Townships of St. Vincent and Sydenham and the former Town of Meaford.

As each of the existing By-laws are to be repealed and replaced with a new By-law, anyone with an interest in property and/or development is encouraged to make themselves aware of what is proposed and become engaged in the planning process.

Significant changes have been made in this revised draft of the by-law in light of comments received from the Public and the Grey Sauble Conservation Authority. Those individuals having commented on a prior version of the draft by-law are strongly advised to review the current REVISED DRAFT.

The document (both text and mapping) is now available for review on the Municipality's website (www.meaford.ca), at the Municipal Offices or by contacting the Planning & Development Department.

The draft By-law is proposed to be applied to all lands throughout the Municipality that are not within the Niagara Escarpment Planning Area (except for the Rural Settlement Areas of Griersville and Woodford, where the draft By-law is proposed to be applied) and the Department of National Defence Meaford Range and Training Area. Considering the above, no key maps are attached to this notice.
