MEMORIAL PARK DESIGNATED OFF-LEASH AREAS

Rules and Regulations

Hours of Use: Sunrise to Sunset

The purpose of these rules are to make sure all enjoy the park and ensure the safety of the users and their pets.

- All dogs shall have a current annual municipal dog license/ tag attached to the collar
- All dogs shall have up to date vaccinations, including the rabies vaccine
- All dogs must be healthy
- No person shall tease, torment, annoy, scream, chase or abuse any dog
- No person shall cause, permit or allow their dog to run at large outside the leash free dog park area
- Limit of three dogs per person
- Dogs that are required to be muzzled and secured by a leash through an 'order' are not permitted to run at large in the off-leash dog park area
- No person shall cause permit or allow their pit-bull to use the leash free dog park (pit-bulls include pit-bull terrier, Staffordshire bull terrier, American Staffordshire terrier, American pit-bull or dog that has an appearance and physical characteristics that are substantially similar), as per the Provincial legislation.

Common Ground Rules for Using this Park

- All children under the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult in the leash free dog park
- No aggressive dogs. If your dog becomes unruly or rough with another dog, immediately leash and remove the dog from the dog park
- No choke collars or collars with spikes permitted (for the safety of all dogs)
- No digging by dogs (if digging does occur, please fill any holes)
- No female dogs in heat are permitted
- No puppies under the age of 4 months (due to limited vaccinations)
- No dog toys of any kind are permitted in the leash free dog park areas
- No smoking, vaping, cannabis, alcoholic beverages or food are permitted in the leash free dog park areas
- Do not allow your child to approach or pet a dog without the owner's presence and permission

Liability is the owner's responsibility. You are legally and financially responsible for your dog's behaviour. Owners/Handlers who disregard these rules will lose privileges to all leash free park areas and may be fined in accordance with established municipal by-laws and the Ontario's Dog Owners Liability Act (DOLA) as governed under the Provincial Offenses Act.

Respect the rights of others. Be safe and have fun!
